Fairmont, WV's Steve Baker won the biggest race of his 31 year career by winning the UFO Pizza Hut Pittsburgher 100 for late models. Baker, driving the Bill Bland Motorsports #0, grabbed the lead on the first lap from his outside front row starting spot and led the entire distance, but it was not an easy victory for the "WV Rim Rider."

After a couple of yellows on the first lap, the green was thrown with Brandon Burgoon and Baker bringing the field down for the start, with Baker grabbing the lead. Burgoon and Lou Bradich (driving a Baker team car) moved into second and third. Bradich made his way past Burgoon on lap 2 and moved into second, while Josh Richards who started 10th made his way to fourth by lap 4. A yellow tightened things up on lap 7, and on the restart Richards made his way past Bradich and Burgoon to move into second. By lap 10 Baker had a half straight lead, with Richards in second, Bradich in third followed by Burgoon and Gary Stuhler. Another yellow appeared, and on that restart Baker led Richards, Bradich, Stuhler, and Lynn Geisler, who moved into fifth. Baker began to pull away again and one of the longer green flag segments occurred, as Baker began to lap cars on lap 18. Baker began to put some traffic and distance between himself and Richards when the next yellow appeared on lap 34. On the restart Baker grabbed the top spot again with Richards, 18th starting Doug Dodd (who put on a wild charge to the top 3), and likewise for B-Main winner and 21st starting Al Atallah who moved into fourth, and Geisler in fifth. Another yellow on the very next lap set the field for another restart. Baker again pulled away on the restart, while Dodd and Burgoon moved past Richards into second and third, with Geisler still in fifth. Richards slowed on the front straight with a flat on lap 38, bringing out another yellow. After another yellow on lap 39, the race got going again, with Baker leading Dodd, Burgoon, Geisler and Atallah behind. Baker began to pull away again; meanwhile, Davey Johnson began to make his presence known, as he moved into fourth on lap 42. Baker led with Dodd, Geisler, Johnson, and now Gregg Satterlee who moved into fifth on lap 43. A yellow appeared on lap 51, with another quickly coming out quickly on lap 52. On the next restart it was Baker, Dodd, Satterlee, Johnson and Geisler. The next yellow appeared on lap 56, when Josh Richards suffered his second flat of the event, after moving into sixth and was tagged by Alex Ferree. Ferree kept going, and Richards returned to the event with new rubber. The next yellow appeared for Satterlee, who was running 5th at the time, slowed and pitted on lap 60 and was done for the night. On the restart it was Baker, Dodd, Johnson, Jeremy Miller, and Alex Ferree. 2008 Point Champ Jared Miley was the next yellow on lap 65, and Lou Bradich brought out another on lap 68. After that restart it was Baker, Johnson, Dodd, Miller and Geisler. The next 24 laps went with out any cautions, and Baker was able to pull away from Johnson and began to lap cars again. By lap 90 Baker was able to pull away to a ½ lap lead over Johnson, who was followed by Miller, Dodd and Alex Ferree. The next caution appeared on lap 93. On the restart, Baker was not able shake Johnson as he was on the earlier restarts and with two to go Johnson began to challenge Baker. On the last lap Johnson got under Baker coming for the checker, but Baker was able to hold him off at the checker in an exciting finish. Dodd was a strong third, while Alex Ferree came back from being lapped thanks to the lucky dog rule to finish fourth, Richards was able to recover from the two flats to end up fifth followed by Jeremy Miller, Matt Lux, Geisler, Atallah, and Dave Hess. It was Baker's 7th win this season at PPMS and his 37th career win. The heats for the 48 cars on hand went to Lynn Geisler, Steve Baker, Lou Bradich, Ed Ferree, and Josh Richards. Al Atallah and Kyle Lukon won the B-Mains.

Burgettstown, PA's Kyle Lukon, the 2007 PPMS Brougner's Machine Shop Crate Late Model Champ, made his first start of the season in the class a winning one, as he picked up the 25 lap Crate main. In a caution filled race, Lukon grabbed the lead on the first lap and led all 25 laps to pick up the win. Bryant Hank moved into second on lap 1 and chased Lukon the entire distance. Daryl Charlier charged from 9th to finish third, with 2008 Crate Point Champ and 17th starting Mike Pegher, Jr. finishing 4th. Rocky Kugel continued his late season strong run to finish 5th followed by Dennis Curry, who nursed a missing car to finish 6th, 29th starting Michael Davis, Daniel Angelicchio, Josh Holtgraver, and Scott Schempp. The heats for the 29 cars saw Daniel Angelicchio, Scott Schempp and Mark Moats, Jr. picked up the wins. Jason Rider and Michael Davis won heats one and two, but were DQ'd in tech.

Millersburg, OH's Keith Berner won his first ever at PPMS in the UEMS/First Commonwealth Bank/Miley Truck Rental E-Mods 25 lap special. Berner, who is better known for running his late model in the past at PPMS, started 10th and drove a steady race to take the lead off Dave Groves on lap 6 and led the remaining laps to pick up the win. Randy Hall came from 11th to finish second, followed by Dave Groves, popular Jacob Hawkins was fourth, Daryl Charlier, Tom Martineck, Rich Michael, Jr., Tim Peterson, Carl McKinney, and Butch Lambert. The heats saw Andre Layfield, Daryl Charlier, and Randy Hall win. There were 32 cars on hand.

Pat Weldon, Monongahela, PA picked up his 3rd win of 2008 in the Sunoco Race Fuels Pure Stock Special. Pat Hanley grabbed the early lead and led the first 6 laps before 4th starting Weldon took over on lap 7. Weldon held off Tim Folmer and Bill Robertson to pick up the win. Bobby Heim was fourth followed by Hanley, Drew Koteles, Nick Kocuba, Bob Egley, Chuck Kennedy (driving Wayne Carbo's #54), and 2008 Track Champ Jake Simmons. Pat Hanley and Bill Robertson picked up the heats for the 22 cars on hand.

2008 PPMS Point Champ, Pittsburgh, PA's Eric Goldberg picked up his 6th win of the season in the Flynn's Tire and Auto Amateur Stocks. Gary Smith was second, followed by Jeff Broniszewski, Brian Huchko, Darren Ferguson, Ed Wisner, Bruce Hamilton and Dan Duseheid.

Carnegie, PA's Daniel White defeated Tyler Atkinson to pick up his 3rd win of the season in the Imperial Heights Garage Young Gun main. Alec Broniszewski ended up third followed by Tyler Carson, Ricky Steigerwald, Hanna Ramsey, and Brian Beyerbach.
