

The Lynn Geisler team cars of Geisler and Mike Pegher Jr. grab wins at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway June 21, 2008. Wayne Tessean and Justin Pons also win at beat the rains, which postponed the Pure Stock and Amateur Stock mains.

In the Pizza Hut Late Models, Cranberry Twp. PA's Lynn Geisler grabbed his second win of 2008 and his 68<sup>th</sup> career late model win at PPMS. Geisler took the lead on the start from his outside front row starting spot. Geisler led all 25 laps but did not have an easy time of it as point leader Jared Miley challenged him several times during the event. Miley ended up second, with Jim Stephens having a solid run to end up third. Mike Johnson came from 9<sup>th</sup> to finish third while Steve Baker came up from 11<sup>th</sup> to finish fifth. The rest of the top ten included Ben Miley, Dave Wade, D.J. Miller, Kyle Lukon, and Keith Rodriguez. Kyle Lukon had his first career win in the late models by picking up the first late model heat while Keith Rodriguez took the second heat. Lukon, the recent high school graduate, was running seventh in the main when he spun in turns one and two and brought out the event's only caution. Another LM rookie Kari Gasser was having her best run of the season, running sixth when she pulled out with just a few laps to go.

Wexford PA's Mike Pegher Jr. also grabbed his second win of the season in the Brougner's Speed Shop Crate Late Models. Pegher, the team car to Geisler, took the lead from his third starting spot on lap two from Rocky Kugel. Pegher withstood a challenge from Bryant Hank from lap 5 thru lap 15, when Hank slowed and lost second to Tommy Schirnhofer. From that point on Pegher was on cruise and won by a straightaway. Mark Moats, Jr. continued to run strong and passed Schirnhofer for second on the last lap. Schirnhofer ended up third followed by Steve Beatty, Hank, Josh Holtgraver, Daryl Charlier, Justin Lamb and Ken Chernik. Mark Moats Jr. and Tommy Schirnhofer grabbed the heats for the 21 cars on hand.

Austintown, OH's Wayne Tessean grabbed his third win of 2008 and 70<sup>th</sup> career Miley Truck Rental E-Mod feature. This win moved Tessean in sole possession of first in career E-Mod wins at PPMS, ahead of Larry Kugel who had 69. Tessean grabbed the lead at the outset and never looked back in picking up the win. Clayton Kennedy had his best career run to finish a strong second followed by dad Chuck Kennedy, Vince Laboon, Joel Johns, Mike McKee, Bruce Dreistadt, Denny Nakutis, Willy Briggs, and Tom Martineck. Kevin Miller and Daryl Charlier took the heat wins.

The Imperial Heights Garage Young Guns saw Pittsburgh, PA's Justin Pons grab his second win of the season. Pons led from the start and defeated Tyler Atkinson, Sean Graham, Mike Reft, Todd Janus, Tyler Fox, Daniel White, Brian Beyerbach and Hannah Ramsey.
