

In the Pizza Hut Late Model main, Fairmont, WV's Steve Baker continued his hot hand and picked up his 6th feature win of season and 36th career Late Model win at the track. Mike Johnson grabbed the lead at the start of the event with John Flinner and Brandon Burgoon right behind. Steve Baker moved from his sixth starting spot into third on lap 2. On lap 3, Baker moved by Flinner, but Flinner was back in second on lap 4. The trio continued to battle for position for the next eight laps, when Baker got by Flinner for good for second on lap 12. On lap 13 Baker got by Johnson for first in turns one and two to take the lead. Once in front Baker never looked back and won by half a straightaway. Flinner got by Johnson on lap 14, when Johnson tagged the wall in one and two. Johnson pitted shortly afterward. Brandon Burgoon moved into third and held the spot until the end. 2008 Point Champion Jared Miley ran his open motor car and charged from 12th to 4th, with Doug Dodd making his first appearance of the season to finish 5th. The rest of the top 10 included Lance Elson in sixth, also making his first appearance, followed by Mark Banal, Jim Lepro, Lynn Geisler (who suffered a broken ball joint on the last lap), and Kari Gasser. Three heats were run for the 23 cars on hand with Mike Johnson, Lynn Geisler and John Flinner picking up the wins.

The Miley Truck Rental E-Mods ran their special event with Midway, PA's Daryl Charlier picking up his 5th win of the season and third straight. Mike Basich grabbed the lead at the start. A major wreck on lap one eliminated several cars. On lap two second running Jacob Hawkins was spun on the back straight by another car and was hit hard by Joel Johns. Both were eliminated. Basich continued to lead with Wayne Tessean and Daryl Charlier right behind. Charlier moved by Tessean on lap 8 and by Basich for the lead on lap 9. Then Basich got caught up in a 4-car wreck and was done for the night. On the restart Dave Groves, making his first start of the season, moved into second and chased Charlier for the remaining laps. Kevin Miller and Wayne Tessean swapped third place, with Tessean winning out. Miller was fourth, followed by newcomer Jack Young, Bruce Dreistadt, Vince Laboon, Tom Martineck, Brad Westover and Frank McGill. Heats for the 26 cars on hand fell to Chuck Kennedy, Chris Basich and J.E. Stalder. Wayne Tessean is the 2008 Champion.

In the Brougher's Machine Shop Crate Late Model feature, Dormont, PA's Dennis Curry, driving his son Dusty's machine, picked up his first win in several seasons. Curry grabbed the lead on the first lap and never looked back. Scott Schempp ran second until lap 5 when Daryl Charlier moved into second. Charlier was looking for his second win of the night but could not get around Curry. Bryant Hank ran a strong race to finish third followed by Tommy Schirnhofner, Mark Moats, Jr., Neil Isiminger (who was in the Laura Lukon #84 and who recovered from a loose steering wheel on lap 4), Schempp, Mike Pegher, Jr. (who recovered from a lap 5 tangle), Beau Glemba and Josh Holtgraver. Dan "The Greek" Karalagas, Tommy Schirnhofner and Rocky Kugel took the heats for the 25 cars on hand.

Monroeville, PA's Pat Hanley earned his first ever PPMS win in the Sunoco Race Fuels Pure Stocks. Hanley grabbed the lead at the outset and led the entire distance. Nick Kocuba ran second until lap 9 when Chris Schneider moved into second. Craig Koteles moved into second on lap 10, but Schneider was back into second on lap 11. Wayne

Carbo moved into second on lap 12 and held it until the finish. Schneider ended up third followed by Koteles, Bill Robertson, Jake Simmons, Bob Schwartzmiller, Kocuba, Robert Betz, and Eric Pistrowski. The heats fell to Bill Robertson, Chris Schneider, and Wayne Carbo for the 22 cars on hand.

Davy Lee, of Independence, PA, picked up his 4th win of the season in the Flynn's Tire and Auto Amateur Stocks. Lee, who was driving the Tony White #76, took the lead on lap 3 from Brian Huchko and led the remaining distance. Jason Herniak had a strong run to finish second followed by Jeff Broniszewski, Eric Goldberg (who arrived late after competing in a special at Tri-City in the afternoon), J.J. O'Patchen, Edward Wiser, Huchko, and Todd Busch. Butch Levandosky won the heat but did not start the main. Eric Goldberg is the 2008 Track Champ.

The Imperial Heights Garage Young Guns saw Pittsburgh, PA's Justin Pons win his sixth event of 2008. Pons led the entire distance. Daniel White was second, followed by Tyler Atkinson, Brian Beyerbach, Tyler Carson, Hannah Ramsey, Alec Broniszewski and Rick Steigerwald. Justin Pons is the 2008 Champion.
