### **John Flinner Wins UFO PENNational at PPMS! Kevin Schaeffer Tops Sprints!**

Imperial, PA- John Flinner picks up the UFO opener, The Penn National 33, while Kevin Schaeffer wins the Sprint Special, Mark Moats Jr., Daryl Charlier, Chris Schneider, Rich Mason, and Justin Pons win at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway on June 6 2009.

Zelienople, PA's John Flinner picked up his third DirtCar Super Late Model Feature of the season, which was also the UFO opener the Penn National 33. Flinner and Jim Stephans brought the field down for the green, and Flinner jumped out front at the start. Flinner opened up a big lead when the first yellow came out on lap 6 for Lynn Geisler who hit the turn two wall. On the restart Flinner grabbed the lead again with Mark Banal (who was making his first start of the season) in second and Jared Miley in third. Flinner opened up a huge lead, when the yellow came out for a second time on lap 20 for Kyle Lukon. While pacing under the yellow Banal pitted with an overheating car and did not return. Fifth running Tom Beck also pitted and did not return. On the restart Flinner assumed the lead with Alex Ferree now in second and Jared Miley still in third. Flinner did not pull away as much on the next several laps, with Ferree just a few car lengths back. The next caution appeared on lap 27 for Keith Barbara who had radiator problems and had to pit. On the restart Flinner still had the lead now with Jared Miley in second, Brandon Burgoon in third and Ferree now in fourth. Miley tagged the wall in three and four on lap 30 bringing out the next caution. On the restart, Flinner moved ahead again, with Ferree now back up to second, Al Atallah now in third and Burgoon back to fourth. Flinner led the next three laps without any problems to pick up the win. Ferree was second, Atallah was third followed by Burgoon, John Mollick (in his best ever PPMS run) Stephans, Lance Elson, Ben Miley, Mike Norris, and Chuck Medved. John Flinner and Keith Barbara picked up the heat wins.

The Sprint Special saw Kittanning PA's Kevin Schaeffer pick up the win in the first sprint race at PPMS since 2000. Schaeffer grabbed the lead on the outset and led the first three laps until a caution came out. On the restart Ed Lynch Jr., who was third, drove by second running Carl Bowser and Schaeffer to take the lead. Lynch set a torrid pace and pulled away from the field and began lapping slower cars. On lap 13 Lynch Jr.'s fine run came to an end when he ran into the back of a car he was lapping causing him to flip and bring out the red. On the restart, Schaeffer grabbed the lead and led the remaining laps to pick up the win. Rod George was second, followed by Jack Sodeman Jr., Danny Holtgraver, Andy McKisson, Bob Felmlie, Garrett Krummert, Carl Bowser, Russ Sansosti, and Gary Rankin. The heats fell to Ed Lynch Jr., and Rod George.

In the Brougner's Machine Shop Pro Lates, Hookstown PA's Mark Moats Jr. ended a rough stretch to pick up his first win of the season. A large wreck on the first lap involving 10 cars brought out the red. Only three were able to return. On the restart Moats grabbed the lead and led the entire distance, but it was not an easy win as Rocky Kugel moved into second on lap 3 and kept the pressure on him all the way and made a run at him coming for the checker. Moats held him off and at the finish it was Moats, Kugel, Mike Reft (in his best run so far), Justin Lamb, Josh Holtgraver, Kyle Lukon, Tommy Schirnhofner Jr., Steve Beatty (from the tail after having problems in his heat, plus the first lap crash), Steve Banal (making his first start), and Scott Schempp. Tommy Schirnhofner Jr. and Josh Holtgraver picked up the heats.

Midway PA's Daryl Charlier won his third feature of the season in the Miley Truck Rental UMP Modifieds. Charlier grabbed the lead at the start and romped to an easy victory. Chuck Kennedy, making only his second start of the season, was a solid second followed by J.E. Stalder, Tom Martineck, Kari Gasser, Kevin Miller, Clayton Kennedy, Rich Curry, Chris Basich and Jim Plance. The heats fell to Daryl Charlier and Chuck Kennedy.

The Sunoco Race Fuels UMP Sportsman saw a new winner as Creighton PA's Chris Schneider grabbed the win. Schneider used a front row starting spot to grab the lead on the first lap and pull away to a big lead to win the non stop event, his first ever at PPMS. Jake Simmons was second, followed by Pat Weldon, Bob Schwartzmiller, Craig Koteles, Bill Robertson, Nick Kocuba, Danny Rich, Adam Kostelnick and Bill Tennant. Craig Koteles and Vince Kamicker won the heats.

Young Rich Mason Kennedy Twp. PA won a career first feature in the Flynn Tire and Auto Factory Stocks. Mason, who led the entire distance, held off Brian Huchko, who actually moved ahead at one point on the last lap. Huchko was second followed by Gary Koteles, Curt Bish, Garrett O'Patchen, Dan Duseheid, Tony White, Ed Wiser, and Adam Chytil.

The Imperial Heights Garage Sports Compact saw defending champ, Pittsburgh PA's Justin Pons pick up his third win of 2009. Pons led all the way to beat Daniel White, Tyler Carlson, Alec Broniszewski, Ricky Steigerwald, Hannah Ramsey, Nico DaBecco, Tyler Atkinson, and Brittney Davis.
