

Steve Baker wins his second; Beau Glemba wins his first as does Garrett O'Patchen, Bob Schwartzmiller, Daryl Charlier and Justin Pons also win at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway.

Fairmont WV's Steve Baker won his second feature of the season and his 39th career win in the DirtCar Super Late Models. Jim Stephans and Tom Beck brought the field down for the start. Beck grabbed the lead at the start and began to open up a bit of a lead. Mike Johnson moved into second by lap two and 12th starting John Flinger moved into third. Beck continued to lead with Johnson, Flinger, Stephans, and 10th starting Steve Baker following. By lap 7 Flinger began to fade with Stephans and Baker moving by. Beck's run up front ended on lap 13 when he got a flat and stopped going into turn three bringing out a caution. Mike Johnson took the lead on the restart, and led the next lap. Then another caution appeared on lap 15, when John Flinger slowed going into turn one. While pacing on the yellow, Johnson's car lost a fuel pump belt and was pushed into the pits. On the restart that put Jim Stephans in the lead, and Baker was along side. On the restart Baker jumped out in front and led the remaining laps to pick up the win. Ben Miley came from the tail when his car wouldn't start on the original start, to get second with two to go, and in the best run of his young career, Brandon Wearing ran a strong race to get third, followed by Stephans, Lynn Geisler, Brandon Burgoon, Beck, Johnson, Flinger and Bobby Marietta. Steve Baker and Jared Miley won the heats.

In the Brougner's Machine Shop Pro Lates Charleroi PA's Beau Glemba picked up a career first win on dirt. Justin Lamb grabbed the lead at the start and led the first two laps. Jason Rider took over on lap three and was looking strong. A red came out on lap 6 when Terry Kerr slowed in turn four and cut down in front of Ken Chernik who had nowhere to go. Rider grabbed the lead back on the restart and led until lap 16 when Glemba made his move on the outside. Glemba, who started 4th, led the last four laps to pick up the win. Rider was second, followed by 12th starting Kyle Lukon, Lamb, point leader Rocky Kugel, Mike Reft, Laura Lukon, Mark Moats Jr., Dave Wade, and Colton Flinger. Rocky Kugel and Beau Glemba picked up the heat wins.

In the Miley Truck Rental UMP Modifieds, Midway PA's Daryl Charlier picked up his fifth win of the season. Charlier who started 9th took the lead on lap two from pole sitter Kevin Miller and held off a late race challenge from J.J. Bametzrieder to grab the win. Clayton Kennedy was third followed by Kari Gasser, Miller, Tom Martineck, Bob Damron, Denny Nakutis, Brad Westover, and Sean Graham. The heats saw Kari Gasser and Daryl Charlier.

Robinson Township PA's Bob Schwartzmiller picked up his third Sunoco Race Fuels UMP Sportsman feature. Last week's winner Craig Koteles grabbed the lead at the start with Pat Weldon in second spot. 12th starting Schwartzmiller moved into third on lap 3. Koteles and Weldon put on a side by side battle for the top spot for the next six laps, when Schwartzmiller moved into second. Jake Simmons joined the battle moving into fourth on lap 6. On lap 8 Schwartzmiller made his move and passed Koteles for first. Schwartzmiller led the remaining laps to grab the win. Simmons also got by Koteles and Weldon in the late stages to finish second, followed by Koteles, Weldon, Nick Kocuba,

Robert Betz, Mike Mohn, Dave Slade, Tyler Fox, and Robbie Haught. The two heats saw Nick Kocuba and Pat Weldon grab wins.

Bethel Park PA's Garrett O'Patchen won his career first feature in the Flynn's Tire and Auto Factory Stocks. Tony White led the first lap before he spun in turn one. Rich Mason led the three laps before O'Patchen took over and lead the rest of the way. Mason was second followed by Jason Herniak, Edward Wisner, Jennifer Barker, Todd Busch, Drew Koteles, White, Curt Bish and Brian Huchko. Garrett O'Patchen also won the heat making it a clean sweep.

Pittsburgh PA's Justin Pons picked up his 4th win of the season in the Imperial Heights Garage Sport Compacts. Pons battled with Daniel White and Tyler Atkinson thru the event to grab the win.
