

Davey Johnson and Jared Miley Win the Twin 31 UFO/ULMS Races, while Mike Reft, J.J. Bametzrieder, Jake Simmons, Gary Koteles and Joe Gombach III also win at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway.

Davey Johnson Greensburg, PA made his first start at PPMS a winning one as he picked up the win in the first leg of the UFO/ULMS DIRTcar Super Late Model twin 31 lap events. Kyle Lukon and Boom Briggs brought the field down for the start. Briggs grabbed the lead and led the first 4 laps before 4<sup>th</sup> starting Tony Musolino took over. While Musolino led, 5<sup>th</sup> starting Steve Baker moved into second, and 15<sup>th</sup> Starting Davey Johnson was working his way thru the field. Musolino had opened up a pretty good lead in just a few laps, and Baker began to close in. Musolino got into traffic by the 10<sup>th</sup> lap and that was his downfall. On lap 14 he tangled with a car he was lapping on the front straightaway, and hit the wall bringing out the caution. Baker took over at this point with Tommy Beck in second, Kyle Lukon in third and Davey Johnson in fourth. On the restart third running Kyle Lukon made an abrupt right turn into the first turn wall, and was hit by Keith Barbara, who in turn was hit by Alex Ferree. Both Barbara and Lukon were thru for the night, while Ferree was able to make repairs and continue. On the restart Baker opened up a lead, while Beck, Johnson, Mike Johnson and Jared Miley scrambled for second. Davey Johnson moved into second and set out after Baker, but Baker continued to maintain a good lead. The pair got into traffic around lap 25, and Baker was passing a lapped car when he tagged the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> turn wall, damaging the rear of his car. He continued but had slowed his pace a bit allowing Davey Johnson to pass him on lap 27. From that point on the race was Johnson's as he led the final laps to pick up the win. Jared Miley, who started 17<sup>th</sup>, was also able to get around Baker in the late stages leaving Baker a disappointing third. Al Atallah came from 11<sup>th</sup> to finish fourth followed by Mike Johnson, Beck, PPMS point leader Brandon Burgoon, John Mollick, Boom Briggs, and Jim Stephans. It was Davey Johnson's 43<sup>rd</sup> career PPMS Late Model Victory.

The second race saw South Park PA's Jared Miley pick up his 4<sup>th</sup> PPMS win of the season. Mel Minnick Jr. and Bob Close started on the front row after an invert 14 was decided for the second feature. Minnick grabbed the lead at the start and led the first 7 laps before 8<sup>th</sup> starting Brandon Burgoon took over on lap 8. Steve Baker charged from 12<sup>th</sup> to second and set sail for Burgoon. Miley charged from 13<sup>th</sup> to third by lap 13 and went after Baker and Burgoon. Miley got by Baker on lap 17 for second and made his winning move on Burgoon lap 20. From that point it was all Miley as he opened up a good lead to the finish. Davey Johnson who started 14<sup>th</sup> moved into second past Burgoon on lap 25, but ran out of time in catching the fleet Miley. Burgoon ended up 3<sup>rd</sup>, while Tommy Beck was 4<sup>th</sup> and Steve Baker fading to 5<sup>th</sup>. They were followed by Mike Johnson, John Mollick, Brent Rhebergen, Alex Ferree, and Boom Briggs. The heats for the 32 Late Models on hand went to Boom Briggs, Keith Barbara and Mike Johnson. The B-Main went to Brandon Burgoon. The win was Jared Miley's 14<sup>th</sup> career PPMS win.

The Brougher's Machine Shop Pro Lates saw Whitehall PA's Mike Reft pick up his second win of the season. Reft started on the pole, and chased outside pole sitter Rocky Kugel for the first 11 laps before taking the lead on lap 12. From that point on Reft was on a roll, and pulled away for the win. Kugel was second, with Dennis Niederriter in third

followed by Kyle Lukon, Jason Rider, Dan Karalagas, Mark Moats Jr., Scott Schempp, Thomas Dembowski, and Neil Isiminger (who was in the Darrell Dow #5J). Mark Moats Jr. and Kyle Lukon grabbed the heats.

In the Sunoco Race Fuels UMP Sportsman, McKees Rocks PA's Jake Simmons picked up his 5<sup>th</sup> win of the season and second in a row. Pat Weldon grabbed the lead at the start and led the first 11 laps before 5<sup>th</sup> starting Simmons took over. Simmons led the remaining 4 laps to pick up the win. Weldon was second followed by Craig Koteles, 17<sup>th</sup> starting Danny Rich, Bob Schwartzmiller, Nick Kocuba, Pat Hanley, Joe Koteles, Wayne Carbo, and Vince Kamicker. Craig Koteles and Jake Simmons won the heat races.

J.J. Bametzrieder McMurry PA picked up his first win of the season in the Miley Truck Rental UMP Modifieds in a wild finish. Chuck Kennedy led the first three laps before 3<sup>rd</sup> starting Bametzrieder took over on lap 4. Bametzrieder battled with J.E. Stalder and Kari Gasser for the lead for the next 8 laps before Stalder grabbed the lead on the last lap. But coming for the checker, Stalder spun out allowing Bametzrieder to cross the line in first followed by Gasser, Daryl Charlier, Wayne Tessean, Chuck Kennedy, Kevin Miller, Denny Nakutis, Jared Domhoff, Chris Basich and Sean Graham. The heats saw Wayne Tessean and Daryl Charlier pick up wins.

The Flynn's Tire and Auto Factory Stocks saw Stockdale PA's Gary Koteles pick up his 7<sup>th</sup> win of the season and second in a row. Koteles grabbed the lead at the start of the event from his outside front row starting spot and led the entire distance. Ian Tomei was second followed by Dan Duseheid, Brian Huchko, Rich Mason, Jason Herniak, Edward Wisner, Jennifer Barker, Kenny Puglishi Jr. and Garrett O'Patchen.

The Imperial Heights Garage Sport Compacts had Latrobe PA's Joe Gombach III pick up his first win of the season. Gombach, who was disqualified from a win earlier in the season, made up for it by starting 6<sup>th</sup>, and grabbing the lead on lap 5 from two time winner Daniel White. Once in front Gombach led the rest of the way. Tyler Atkinson was second followed by White, Nico DaBecco, Justin Pons, Tyler Carlson, Hannah Ramsey, Brittney Davis and Rick Steigerwald.
